Online registration for IPhO 2013 will be available from 6<sup>th</sup> May. An email will soon be sent to the leaders, containing login, password and further instructions on how to register all participants. Deadline for registration is the 20<sup>th</sup> May.

## Fees and Payment

As an established custom of the International Physics Olympiad, each participating country is asked to contribute a voluntary fee of 3,500 EUR. The fee will cover meals, accommodation and social events during the official period of the Olympiad. Observers and visitors are most welcome, but are required to pay the registration fee of 1,900 EUR per observer and 1,800 EUR per visitor. Observers are allowed to attend all Olympiad meetings, including the meetings of the International Board, but without rights of voting and discussion. Visitors may attend ceremonies and excursions, but there is no special program planned.

## **Transportation**

Transportation from Copenhagen Airport or Copenhagen Central Station to the hotels and hostels, transportation during the event and vice versa are fully covered by the Organizing Committee (7-15 July).

To ensure the best possible flight arrangements, an agreement with Star Alliance has been made which offers discounts on airline tickets, if traveling with one of the participating airlines. Arrangements have been made for students to stay at Danhostel Copenhagen City located in central Copenhagen.
